SGJ Pinot Blanc dry

This Pinot Blanc is characterized by a fine, fruity bouquet, a blend of ripe, yellow-fleshed pear, quince and peach with pineapple aromas, and an invigorating, very slight acidity. The pale-to-bright-yellow color in the glass is just as delicate as the scent.

SGJ Blanc de Noirs trocken

"Blanc de Noirs" is the French term for a white wine vinified from red grapes, as is the case here. An invigorating aroma of apple and citrus flavors. The flavor is reminiscent of gooseberries and a very slight hint of strawberry. The taste is delicate, creamy, fresh, and lively with an elegant, stimulating acidity.
